Music from the Movies says “Douglas Romaine Is A Composer Who Is Well And Truly On The Way Up!” His music is critically acclaimed for haunting magical melodies, rich lush orchestrations, edgy sonorities, brilliant dramatic textures and sophisticated writing.

Romaine’s honors include the **Outstanding Achievement in Film Music Gold Medal** from Park City Film Music Festival, **Best Use of Film Score Award** from The Film & TV Music Academy Awards and a **BMI Film Music Award**. He co-composed the Looney Tunes space-adventure series Duck Dodgers honored with an **Annie Award for Outstanding Achievement in Music in an Animated Television Production** and was Associate Music Director on the Emmy-nominated “Once More, With Feeling” Buffy the Vampire Slayer episode with Christophe Beck, who received an Emmy nomination himself for Outstanding Music Direction.

Scoring credits include the television series **Buffy the Vampire Slayer, Angel: The Series, Duck Dodgers** and **Miracles** and numerous award-winning independent films, including **A Son’s War, H.H. Holmes, Rocketboy, Marooned?, Freedomland, Shelter, The End of All Things,** and **The Truth About Faces**. He also contributes additional music, conducting and orchestration on studio projects, including on **Big Fat Liar, Stealing Harvard, The Skulls II, The Skulls III** and **I-60: Episodes of the Road**.

Romaine lives in Los Angeles, where he scores film, television and new media at Back Pocket project studio, run carbon-neutral using green energy. He is a member of Film Independent, The Society of Composers and Lyricists and the American Federation of Musicians Local 47. The Agency Group/LA and Bleu Jean Mgmt represent him.
